Matt's been busy finding these great beers and more yet to come, but I can only tell you about them. You'll have to try them for yourself!

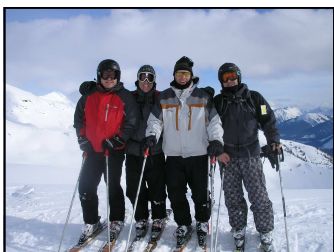
